John 20:24-29 New American Standard Bible (NASB)

1) There is always a Purpose in His Presence:

v.26 ^{b]}After eight days His disciples were again inside, and Thomas with them. Jesus *came, the doors having been ^[c]shut, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace *be* with you."

- What does He want me to see?

Gen.: 17:15-21 (When Sara and Abraham are told they were going to have a child at the age of 100 and 90)

v.27 Then He *said to Thomas, "Reach here with your finger, and see My hands; and reach here your hand and put it into My side; and do not be unbelieving, but believing.

Gen.: 18:14 (Is anything too hard for the Lord)
